Applications for out of zone enrolment will now be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority must be given to students who have been accepted for enrolment in the following special programme(s) run by the school and approved by the Secretary for Education. **(Not applicable to Ramarama School)**

Second Priority must be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

Third Priority must be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth Priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

Fifth Priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989.

Applicants seeking second, third or fourth priority status will be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.

If the number of applications exceeds the number of available spaces, a ballot is necessary, this will take place on Wednesday, 21st October 2026, and all applicants will be notified in writing by Friday, 23rd October 2026.
